


Colliers Wood Residents Association (CWRA): Resident Engagement

(It is noted that the survey didn't allow multiple answers and that people may be interested in more than one area – this was an error in the set-up).


- The majority of comments were around fly-tipping and street rubbish generally

What would encourage people to attend more often?


- Keep meetings more structured

- Options to 'call-in' if people are unable to attend

- More targeted areas of work
- Alternating times
- Agenda released in advance
- A more sociable approach introductions and light refreshments

Why aren't people using the website?


- A number of people said that they didn't know it existed

Answered: 55 Skipped: 1




How we will improve communication
